Open to male singers of all ages, Measure for Measure: A Men's Choral Society was founded in 1988 to provide an opportunity for singers to perform music composed and arranged for male voices. If you love to sing and can read music, come and see what we are all about.

Measure for Measure performs with many outstanding musical groups, such as the University of Michigan Men's and Women's Glee Clubs, Motor City Brass Band, Windsor Classic Chorale, and selected Michigan high school choruses. Venues include Hill Auditorium, St. Francis of Assisi Church, the Ford Community and Performing Arts Center, and wonderful churches across Southeast Michigan.

Measure for Measure holds weekly rehearsals on Sunday evenings, 6:30-9:00PM, in Alexander Hall 109, on the campus of Eastern Michigan University.

## **Auditions**

Participation in Measure for Measure remains open to all by audition, held in September and January of each year. We strongly encourage prospective members to attend our rehearsals, with auditions immediately following.

The content of a Measure for Measure audition is as follows:

### **Vocalization**

The singer will perform a series of vocalization exercises to determine the range and color of the voice.

### **Sightreading**

The singer is given a short excerpt from TTBB selection, and is asked to sing their part while the other three parts are played by an accompanist.

### **Interview**

A short, informational interview is held with the Measure for Measure Board to provide more details about the ensemble.

Prospective members will be notified of results within 48 hours of the audition.
